While we aim to follow the above schedule as closely as possible, students are requested to remember that the hospital is not a purely educational institution, and they must be prepared to vary their course as necessitated by hospital emergencies.

Hours vary according to the needs of the various sections of the department and according to the ability of the student to finish work assigned to her.

Board and laundry, but not room, are furnished by the hospital. Rooms may be secured in the vicinity for \$6. to \$8. per week.

Plain white, long-sleeved uniforms with white Oxford shoes with rubber heels and white stockings are required. Six uniforms are generally needed. We suggest "Bob Evans" or "White Swan" uniforms with long sleeves and a plain navy blue sweater for corridor wear for winter. Hair nets must be worn on duty.

A certificate will be granted upon satisfactory completion of the course.
